SCOPE OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Provides direct special education instruction and service minutes to student with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).
- 2. Maintains service tracker for each student who has an IEP on file.
- 3. Creates goals and objectives based on data (e.g., academic achievement assessments, psychoeducational evaluations, functional behavior assessments).
- 4. Consults and collaborates with general education teachers about academic and/or behavior concerns.
- 5. Participates in IEP meetings to present students' academic goals and objectives progress.
- 6. Serves as the special education teacher IEP team member.
- 7. Conducts academic assessments for initials and reevaluations.
- 8. Provides students with clear behavior expectations; establishes a classroom environment that is safe and supportive to promote a positive learning environment for students and school staff.
- 9. Follows policies and procedures for reporting incidents of child abuse.
- 10. Communicates effectively with families.
- 11. Seeks advice from the Special Education Director when any academic and/or behavior is reported teachers.

MINIMUM REQUIRED EXPERIENCE

An earned bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
