HOMECOMING 2009 TAIL GATE GUIDELINES

*****SITE*****

1. Vehicles will only be admitted between 8:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. to keep the reservation you have made. No more than one car will be permitted per site (a vehicle is not necessary to reserve a site).
2. Sites will be assigned once you arrive the morning of the event.
3. Site must be completely decorated and ready for judging by 12:30 p.m.
4. Each tailgate site should have a name.
5. Tailgaters should decorate in the theme of “49er Days: 60 Years in the Making.”
6. Please choose the tailgate space size you would like on the Tail Gate Sign-up Sheet. Tailgate decorations must remain inside the boundary lines. The Homecoming Committee will mark boundaries.
7. Each tailgate space should have a “Site Captain.” The Captain completes the site registration form, is ultimately responsible for set-up and clean up, must remain for the entire event, and will receive a prize if their site wins.
8. A limited number of tailgate spaces are available and reservations must be made in advance by e-mailing Caitlin Roberts at the Student Life and Development Office at crobert5@csulb.edu. Reserve your space by Tuesday, November 10th, 2009.
9. Each site must be cleaned up at the conclusion of Homecoming. If you are using sand in your site, you need to remove it the same way you brought it in. **DO NOT PUT SAND IN THE TRASH CANS!** Cars will not be allowed to exit the Homecoming site until 5:00 p.m.
10. No music will be permitted in the tailgate area, as it will interfere with the bands performing.
11. **NO OFF CAMPUS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN THE TAIL GATE AREA.**
12. Organizations may not participate in or host games that appear to promote or condone alcohol consumption (root beer pong, etc.)
13. **Food and Beverages will be available for purchase at the Homecoming Event;** however if you plan to bring your own food and BBQ, only Gas operated barbeques will be allowed into the tailgate area. **NO CHARCOAL PLEASE!** Organizations may only provide food and beverages for members of their own organization.

An impartial panel will be judging. Winners will be recognized and announced at the Homecoming program.
