TEXT OF PROPOSAL: The proposal for the pedagogical stipend must include a description of the proposed 3-hour ethics module that will be integrated into a course the faculty member teaches, highlighting the relevant ethical issues in the faculty member's discipline. The proposal should include the books and other source materials that will be utilized. The text of the proposal must be prepared using 12-point type and 1-inch margins and may not exceed three (3) pages in length. Please do not use double spacing or a bold font.

- 9. LEARNING OBJECTIVES AND ASSESSMENT: In the text of the proposal, be sure to clearly outline the ethics module's applied learning objectives and assessment methods. Emphasize how they are aligned with the syllabus and overall course objectives. Examples of **Learning Objectives** include ethical reasoning and civic knowledge and engagement local and global. Examples of **Assessment** for those objectives include oral presentations and analyzed case studies. See **Essential Learning Outcomes**.
- 10. FACULTY HISTORY OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS: On <u>no more than two separate pages</u>, provide complete citations of journal articles, book chapters, conference presentations, and other intellectual contributions produced during the period covering from July 2015 to June 2018. Acknowledge co-authors (if any) and indicate whether each intellectual contribution is refereed or non-refereed. In addition, list all current and pending internal and external support for your proposed project.
- 11. DELIVERABLE FOR ACCEPTED PROPOSALS: Accepted proposals shall result in a deliverable product to be submitted electronically to the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership no later than **August 19, 2019**. Electronic deliverables will include: 1) a detailed lesson plan for the ethics module including **learning objectives and assessment methods** (see above); appropriate PowerPoint slides for the module; bibliography of journal articles in support of the module; and other supporting materials, such as pertinent case studies with teaching notes on ethics in the faculty member's discipline; and 2) a 500-word summary of the ethics module. The deliverable product will be submitted to the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership and will be made available as part of the Ukleja Center's mission.
- 12. COPYRIGHT: In consideration of the pedagogical stipend awarded to the recipient by the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership, the award recipient hereby grants the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to publish and republish the recipient's work product, including without limitation, book, digital, Internet, and other formats now existing or hereafter developed.
