June 8	Meet at LAX group check-in counter. Depart to Shanghai. (Airlines TBA)	LAX
June 9	In the morning we a city tour including the Yu Garden, Nan Pu Bridge, and Oriental TV Tower.	SHANGHAI
June 10	After breakfast, visit the first Chinese business street, Nanjing Road, with numerous unique shop-stands; visit the water's edge Dongxin scenery, Radio Tower, and the Pudong newly developed area situated at the Whangpoo River. After a traditional Shanghai style dinner, we then travel to WUXI.	WUXI
June 11	We are traveling to Hanzhou which is famous for its West Lake and Ling Yin temple. We will also tour the ancient Chinese buildings and enjoy the unique culture in the city.	HANZHOU
June 12	After breakfast we shall fly to one of China's ancient capitals - Xian. Upon arrival we visit the Wild Goose Pagoda and ancient city wall. A dumpling feast is arranged for tonight's dinner	XIAN
June 13	Xian was the capital of China for 11 dynasties extending over 1000 years. We are going to visit the amazing Terra Cotta Warriors - thousands of life-size clay warriors, horses and chariots which were part of the tomb of the first emperor of the Qin Dynasty. Afterward, we shall visit the Huaqing Hot Spring.	XIAN
June 14	Upon arriving in Beijing, you will meet our professional local guide at the Beijing International Airport. We will then proceed to the Palace Museum, the Forbidden City, Tian An Men Square - the well-known largest square in the world, and the Summer Palace - the largest imperial garden in China. This evening you will enjoy a Chinese acrobatic show with delicious dinner.	BEIJING
June 15	Full-day excursion outside of Beijing to the remarkable Great Wall and legendary Ming Tombs - the last resting place of 13 emperors. Tonight's special dinner gives you a real taste of the famous Peking Duck. We then will take overnight train to Harbin.	BEIJING
