Dr. Kathleen A. Lacey is the Faculty Director of the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership. She assists the Director in managing external relationships, focusing on relationships within the university. Kathleen also oversees the center's board development, programs and services, and public relations.

In addition to the above role, Kathleen is a Professor of Legal Studies in Business and Business Ethics. She directs the Legal Studies in Business Program in the College of Business Administration. Kathleen has been teaching at CSULB since 1994. Her teaching expertise spans business law, business ethics, and ethical leadership. In 2008, Kathleen was one of five faculty members across the campus to receive a *Distinguished Faculty Teaching Award*.

Kathleen has done extensive research in international law and corporate governance and has published articles in the *American Journal of Comparative Law*, *Cornell International Law Journal*, *American Business Law Journal*, and *Northwestern Law Journal*.

A graduate of San Diego State University, Kathleen received her Master of Business Administration and Juris Doctorate degrees from the University of Southern California. She currently serves as President of the Academy of Legal Studies in Business, a national academic organization for business law professors.
