1. A grade of "C" or better in PSY 100 (GE Category D2) or SOC 100 (GE Category D2) or CDFS 111 is the prerequisite for CDFS 211.
2. A grade of "C" or better in CDFS 111 or consent of instructor is the prerequisite for CDFS 214 and CDFS 215
3. A grade of "C" or better in CDFS 111 and upper division standing are the prerequisites for CDFS 311.
4. A grade of "C" or better in CDFS 111 and upper division standing or consent of instructor are the prerequisites for CDFS 314.
5. Completion of GE foundation courses, PSY 100 or SOC 100 or ANTH 120 (GE Category D2), upper division standing, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 312I (GE Categories D2 or E, IC & Capstone) and for CDFS 319I (GE Categories D2 or E, IC, Capstone, and Human Diversity).

6. A grade of "C" or better in CDFS 312I, or consent of instructor is the prerequisite for CDFS 410.
7. CDFS 311 or CDFS 314 or HDEV 307 or PSY 361 or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 411.
8. Upper division standing, CDFS 312I, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 412 and CDFS 413.
9. CDFS 111, 211, 214, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 414.
10. CDFS 111, 211, 215, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 415.
11. Upper division standing and at least 6 units of upper division CDFS or equivalent courses, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for CDFS 418.

In addition, students must maintain a "C" or better in all courses required for the minor.

The minor in Child Development and Family Studies is not available to Child Development and Family Studies majors.
