Application Process

1. Complete the CSULB Graduate/Post-Baccalaureate Application.

2. Send the following to the Gerontology Program Director:

A. 3 letters of recommendation (no specific format required)

At least one letter should be from a college professor or age-related career professional. As appropriate, letters should reflect your academic potential and personal qualifications, as well as your ability, sensitivity, and motivation to work with older adults and professionals in the field of aging.

B. A current resume

Including education, employment, and volunteer activities

C. A personal, written statement (No specific format or length required)

This should describe your interest in aging and your career goals in the field of aging.
