Postmasters NP for MSN – 32 units (everything but Research and Comps, Thesis or Project)

Postmasters NP in another specialty for MSN/NP – 18 units (one year – theory and clinical courses)

6 units may be transferred from another college for Masters degree/5 units for Postmasters NP for MSN transfers
