- 3. The Council of Black Nurses Scholarship Program is offering awards from \$1000-\$1500 for eligible applicants.**

Criteria:

- a. Enrolled in an accredited BSN, ADN, or ADN to BSN program.
- b. Completed at least one semester/quarter of the nursing program. LVN to RN 30 unit option program students may apply during their first semester of the nursing program.
Applicant must not be in the last quarter or semester of the program.
- c. Passing all courses as required by the college or university.
- d. Demonstrate financial needs.
- e. Currently involved or have been involved in service to the African American community (i.e. health fairs, church activities, senior center volunteers, etc).

Application form must be completed and returned by May first of each year, to include the following:

- a. Official transcript from previous semester/quarter.
- b. The report of work in progress form completed and signed by the instructor of each course
- c. Three letters of recommendation with one from a nursing faculty member, one from a community organization in which you are or have been involved and one personal reference
- d. A personal profile about yourself, your long and short term goals and a statement of why you feel you should be a recipient of the scholarship awards.
- e. To obtain a copy of the application form, go to the dept. learning center Scholarship Display Board and make copy of the sample application form attached to the announcement.

4. **Victor E. Schimmel Memorial Nursing Scholarship** will award three scholarships to individuals who are currently enrolled, or have been recently accepted into a college or university for an advanced degree.
