Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing Transfer Information Sheet

Description of Program:

This program is for students who have completed their prerequisites outside of CSULB and have achieved an upper division transfer status. Upon completion of the course of study, the student will be eligible for licensure to practice as a registered nurse, to become a certified public health nurse and to function as a professional nurse in a variety of settings.

Admission Requirements for the Department of Nursing:

- Grade of "C" or better in all prerequisite courses for a minimum GPA of 2.5 (please note that 2.5 is the minimum, but it is not a competitive GPA. The average GPA for admitted students is 3.5 and better).
- Prerequisite Courses that are equivalent to the following CSULB Courses: a combined 5 unit Integrated Chemistry Course Chem 140, Bio 207/Physiology, Bio 208/Anatomy, Micro 200, Quantitative Reasoning, Oral Communication, College Composition, and Critical Thinking course.
 - Equivalencies can be verified for transfer course work at <http://www.assist.org> or in the nursing office.
 - If equivalency cannot be verified, a course waiver must be obtained by the student from the Nursing Department.
 - May have one course in progress at the time of application. Admission is contingent upon receiving a grade of C or better. The GPA will be calculated as a grade of C. Attach copy of proof of enrollment.
- Completion of TEAS Examination administered in the Department of Nursing. Study materials are available on the ATI Testing Web site (www.atitesting.com). If you take (or have taken) the TEAS test elsewhere, please request that ATI Testing (www.atitesting.com) forward your test results to Cal State Long Beach. For information of the content of the TEAS test, please visit: www.atitesting.com.
- Official transcripts from all college level work.

Admission Requirements for CSU, Long Beach Transfers:

- College grade point average of at least a 2.0
- Admitted as a sophomore
- Must include, Quantitative Reasoning, Oral Communication, College Composition, Critical Thinking and the additional prerequisites listed above. See your Community College advisor for GE transferable courses.
- Official transcripts from all college level work.

Admission Procedure:

- Apply to via CSUmentor to CSU, Long Beach by deadline:
Fall- November 30th Spring- August 31st
- Apply to Department of Nursing by deadline using supplemental nursing application below: Fall- February 15th Spring- September 15th
