As a borrower, you may access a wide range of child welfare resource materials to assist you in providing the highest level of direction and guidance to the student(s) in placement at your agency. You may also use these materials to address your everyday job-related resource needs.

The Library houses several thousand child welfare books, training curricula, audiocassettes, and over 600 videotapes. Field Supervisors may check out all types of items.
