The Department of Comparative World Literature and Classics is pleased to announce the annual availability of two \$500 scholarship awards. One award will be available for majors in Comparative World Literature and one for majors in Classics. The Awards will be made to students with financial need who have demonstrated a high level of intellectual and academic potential.

ELIGIBILITY

- **Major in Comparative World Literature or Classics**
- **A minimum of 6 completed units in the major field**
- **Junior or Senior status (over 60 completed units) but not graduating during the semester the application is submitted**
- **A minimum 3.2 Cumulative GPA**
- **A minimum 3.5 GPA in the major field**
- **Demonstrated financial need**

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students must submit the following to apply:

- **Cover Sheet (attached)**
- **Academic writing sample of 1,000 words (may be a class paper)**
- **Two faculty letters of recommendation (at least one from the major)**
- **A statement of academic/professional goals (1 page)**
- **A 9x12 stamped, self-addressed envelope (to return application materials)**

SUBMISSION

Submit all materials to the office of the Department of Comparative World Literature and Classics (MHB 517) by the deadline of May 3, 2010. All applicants will be notified of the awards by May 31, 2010.
