

The Minor in History at CSULB

History is a discipline at the core of the liberal arts tradition. It seeks to preserve, extend, and reevaluate our study of the past, and to connect it with the present. History can illuminate other disciplines and deepen our understanding of how the world works. History has several areas of emphasis making it an exciting complement to any Major.

Requirements for the Minor in History (code 0-8525)

A Minimum of twenty one (21) units which must include:

Lower Division: A minimum of six (6) units which *must* include a six unit sequence from either: HIST 211 and HIST 212 or HIST 131 and HIST 132.

Upper Division: A minimum of twelve (12) units, which *must* include at least six (6) units in each of two (2) fields of emphasis. The fields are:

- A. Africa and the Middle East
- B. Ancient and Medieval Europe
- C. Asia
- D. Latin America
- E. Modern Europe (including Britain)
- F. United States

Or a Topical Area/Field selected with the advice of a faculty member with whom you will work.
