The Los Angeles Times has a paid summer internship in photojournalism for college students. The Times offers a hands-on journalism work experience. Previous newspaper internship experience is preferable. This is an advanced internship where you will be working on photo stories as well as daily photojournalism.

QUALIFICATIONS

- You must be actively working toward a college degree, but graduates may be eligible if you've finished school within six months of the start of the internship.
- Internships are for students who have not worked professionally as staff photographers.
- Interns should have a valid driver's license and access to a car in good working condition.

TO APPLY PLEASE SUBMIT

- Brief cover letter
- One page autobiography
- Resume
- An on line portfolio with a minimum of 20 single images and three complete photo stories.
- List of three references
