Student Projects

Want to join us at the 27th Annual NAHJ Convention and Media & Career Expo in Puerto Rico while working in a live newsroom setting? Well here is your chance. Dozens of aspiring journalists will work side by side with professionals and mentors to produce solid and innovative journalism in English and in Spanish primarily for The Latino Reporter Digital on the web, but across other media platforms as well. Students will be trained in video, audio, webcasting, podcasting and multimedia skills that are now key to building a solid resume. NAHJ covers travel, lodging, a meal stipend, and registration for the convention for those students selected to participate. The deadline to apply is March 31st.

Student Campus

The Student Campus is designed for college students interested in learning more about the changing world of journalism in the early stages of their career development, primarily freshmen and sophomores. The students participate in intensive training, tours, mock press conferences and career-building exercises in classrooms, television studios, media outlets, the streets and neighborhoods of San Juan, seminars on journalism ethics, and get advice on how to obtain journalism internships and make the most out of the networking experience at the NAHJ Convention. The 2-3 day session takes place just before the convention and ends right when the convention starts so participants can fully avail themselves of the training and networking the conference has to offer. NAHJ covers travel, lodging, a meal stipend, and registration for the convention for those students selected to participate. The deadline to apply is March 31st.

Every year NAHJ offers scholarships to 20-30 aspiring Latino journalists and other students committed to journalism through the NAHJ Rubé® Salazar Scholarship Fund and donations from Univision Anchor Marij Elena Salinas, FOX News Channel Senior Correspondent Geraldo Rivera, the S.I.
