PAID INTERNSHIPS

The Register offers internships throughout the year, including part-time posts during the fall and spring semesters (150 hours over 10 weeks) and full-time posts in the summer (400 hours over 10 weeks).

WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR

You should demonstrate your commitment to journalism. We prize a strong foundation in your skill area and are rapidly diversifying our newsroom to provide information to meet audience demands. That means we are looking for people with print, broadcast, Web and multimedia skills. We also value proficiency in foreign languages prevalent in Orange County.

POSITIONS

We're looking for reporters, photographers, designers, graphic artists, copy editors, and candidates with experience in multimedia, such as shooting and editing video, slideshows, Flash, and database applications.

TO APPLY

Submit a cover letter describing what you would bring to the internship and what you hope to reap from the experience. Provide an unofficial transcript, a resume and two recommendation letters. Reporters should provide as many as 10 work samples. Photographers, designers and graphic artists should submit as many as 20 samples. Copy-editing finalists will take a test.
