California Launch Vehicle Education Initiative

• Scholarship:

- **Two \$2,000 scholarships** for Summer 2005
- Funds provided by the **California Space Grant Consortium** (NASA)

• Qualifications:

- Demonstrated continuous active participation in CALVEIN prototype launch vehicle development & ASI lab. management
- Enrolled CSULB undergrad. or graduate student – Min. 2.9 GPA
- Major in Aerospace, Mechanical, Electrical Engineering or CECS
- Must be U.S. Citizen or U.S. Resident (federal funds)

• Terms:

- Acceptance of the scholarship supposes taking/continuing to take a **leadership** role in a specific CALVEIN project (e.g. engine development, lab management, NLV development) over the summer for a **period equivalent to approx. 1 month full-time** (e.g. half time for 2 months) – Schedule to be arranged
- Previous CALVEIN scholarship recipients may apply for the scholarship but may receive only one scholarship per period (Fall/Spring/Summer)
