- **Scholarship:**

- **\$2,000 scholarship** for Fall/Winter 2007
- Funds provided by the **NASA California Space Grant Consortium**

- **Qualifications:**

- Knowledge of **PHP, Python, Perl and Labview for web applications**
- Demonstrated continuous active participation in CALVEIN prototype launch vehicle development and/or ASI lab. Management
- Enrolled CSULB graduate student – Min. 3.0 GPA
- Major in CECS, Electrical, Aerospace, Mechanical Engineering
- Must be U.S. Citizen or U.S. Resident (federal funds)

- **Terms:**

- Acceptance of the scholarship supposes taking a leading and supervisory role working with an undergraduate student in the development of a **remote flight operations web application** over the Fall & Winter for a **period equivalent to approx. 10 weeks part-time** – Schedule to be arranged and technical details to be discussed
- Previous CALVEIN scholarship recipients may apply for the scholarship but may receive only one scholarship per period (Fall/Spring/Summer)
