

# MATHEMATICS DIAGNOSTIC PLACEMENT TEST REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Please read the following information before registering for the test.**

## Who needs to take the test?

The Mathematics Diagnostic Placement Test (MDPT) is mandatory for freshmen who want to take one of the following classes and have **not** taken the prerequisite.

- Math 119A: Survey of Calculus I
- Math 122: Calculus I

### THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS ARE EXEMPT:

- Freshmen who are enrolled in, and are passing the prerequisite to the mathematics course they intend to enroll in. This only applies to the courses listed above.

If you are unsure which mathematics course you need to take, please check the CSULB Catalog and/or the department of your prospective major.

The MDPT Calculus Readiness exam is a multiple choice test that consists of 2 components; trigonometry and algebra. To fully evaluate your mathematical skills, the use of a **calculator is not allowed**. To get an idea of the type of question you can expect, please check the section with sample questions. Be aware that you will be taking the Calculus Readiness exam, not the Mathematical Analysis exam.

## When is the test offered?

The MDPT will be offered on:

- Friday June 13, 2008
- Friday June 27, 2008
- Friday July 11, 2008
- Science Safari June 20, 2008. OPEN TO SCIENCE SAFARI STUDENTS ONLY!

The next available opportunity to take this test is during the Fall 2008 semester.

On the day of the test, please bring the following:

- Valid Photo ID with the name you used to register for the test.
- Pencils & eraser.

**Students who are late and those without a valid form of photo identification might not be admitted!**

## How much is the registration fee?

There is no registration fee for the MDPT.

## How do I register?

## Test Location.
