

VIDEO PROJECTOR CARTS

Video Projectors carts consist of:

- An Video Projector
- A VCR
- A DVD Player

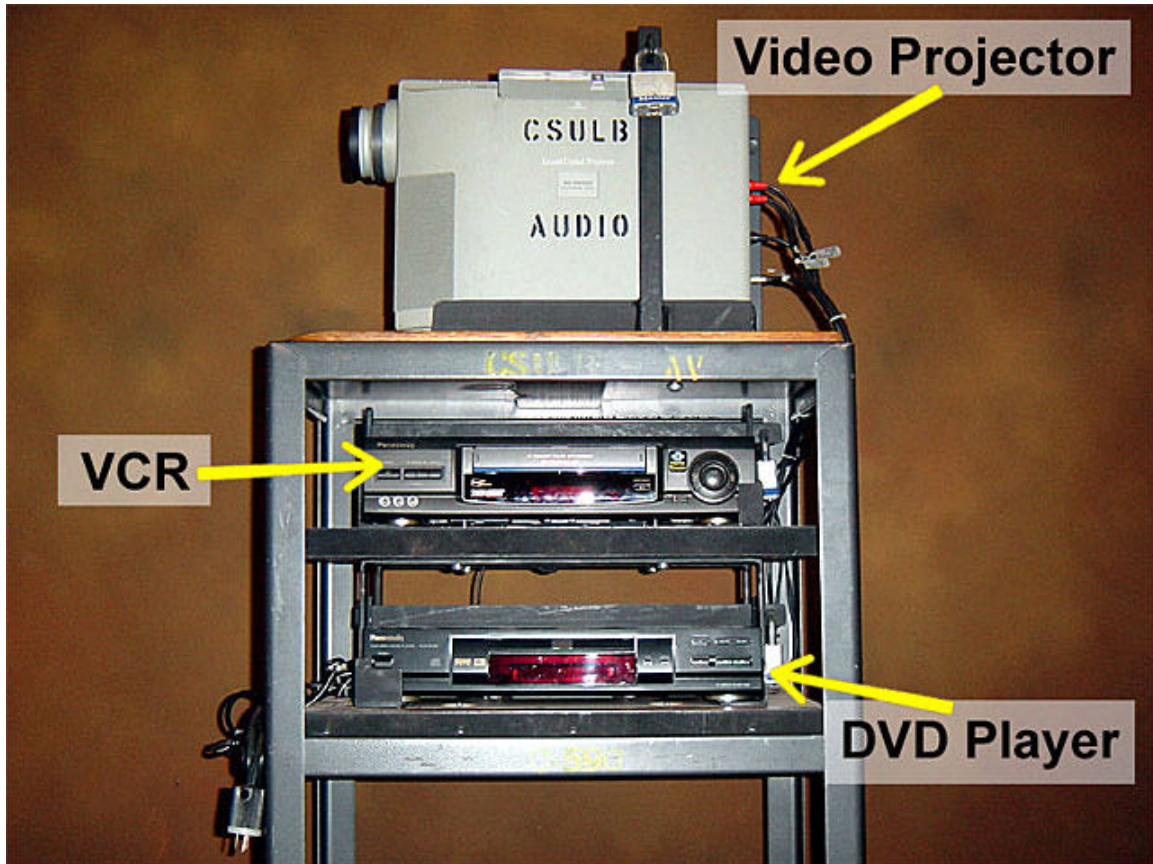


Figure 1: Video Projector Cart

These are mounted on a “**Power Cart**”. A **Power Cart** has a power strip attached to the back. The **Video Projector**, **VCR**, and **DVD Player** are all plugged into the power strip. The power strip is then plugged into the wall outlet.

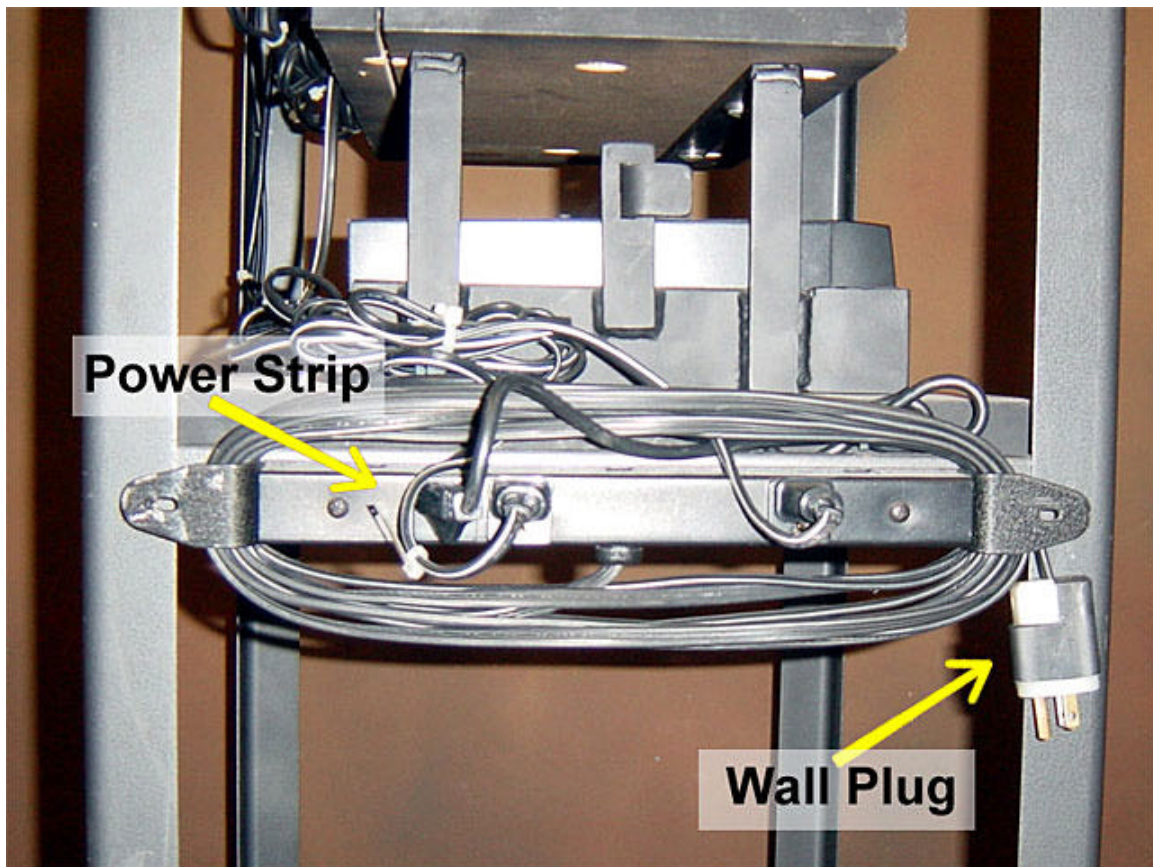


Figure 2: Power Strip

The Video Projector

1. The **On/Off** button for the Video Projector is on the top front of the projector. The **Control Panel** is under a cover along the top edge of the Projector next to the On/Off Button.

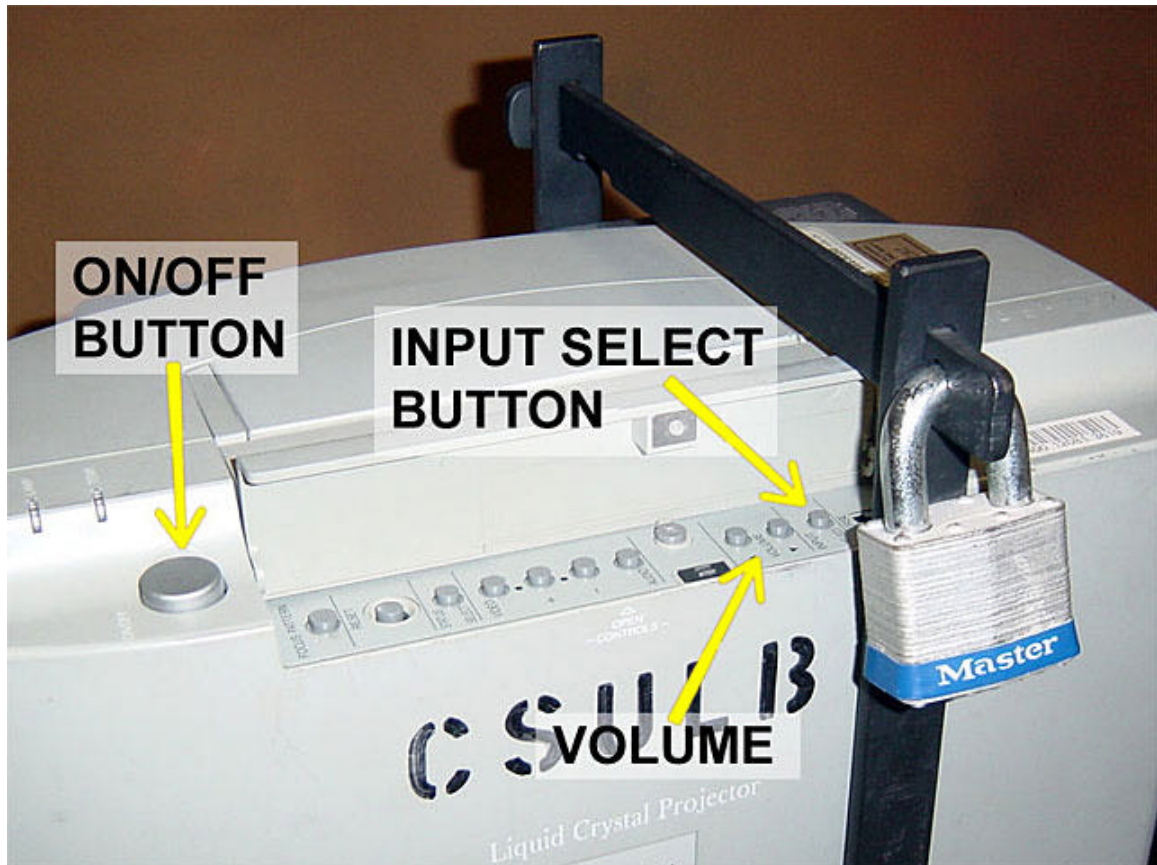


Figure 3: Video Projector Control Panel

2. If you are using the **VCR** to play a **VHS video tape** push the **Input Select** button repeatedly until **Video 2** appears on the screen.
3. If you are using **DVD Player**, push the input button until **S-Video 1** appears on the screen.
4. Adjust the **Volume** using the **Volume Control** buttons

Adjusting the Picture

Change the size of the image on the screen using the **Zoom** lens. The Zoom lens is the black outer ring on the lens. **Focus** the image by turning the inner lens.

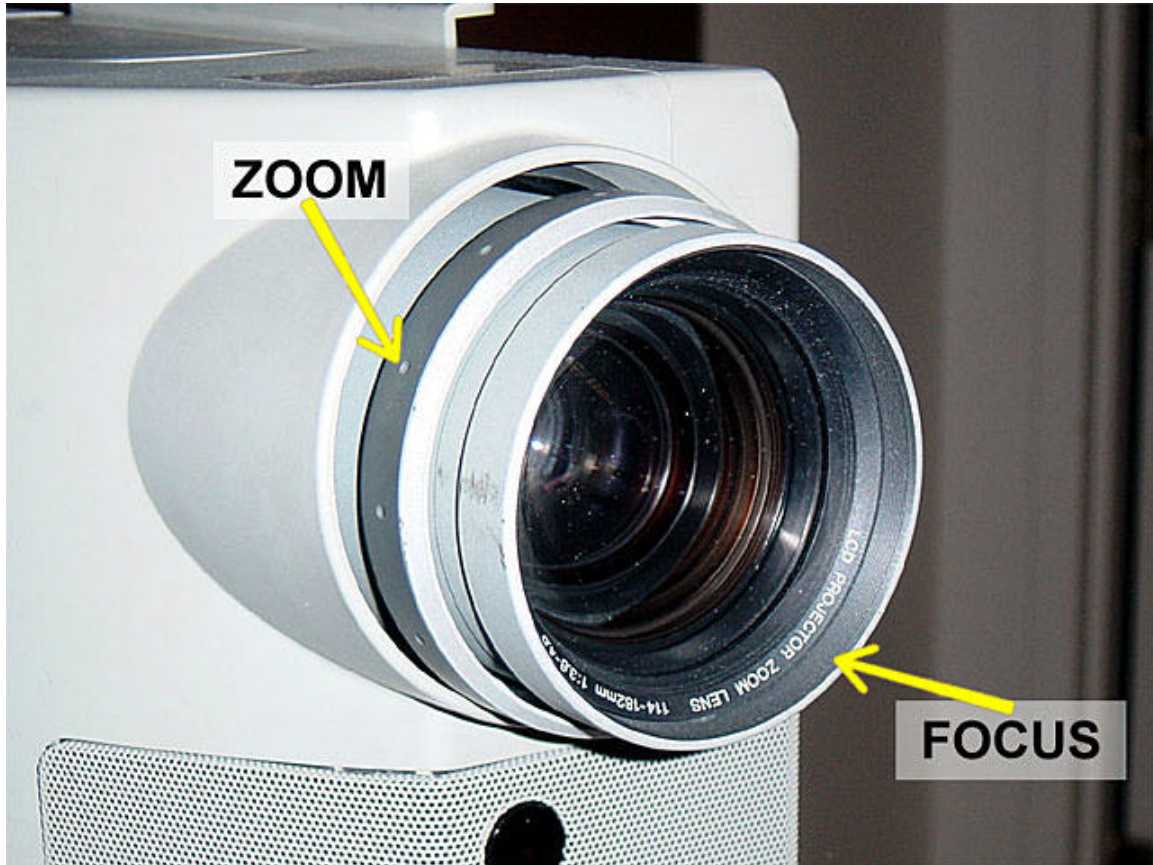


Figure 4: Zoom Lens

The VCR

1. Press the **Power** button to turn the VCR on.
2. Insert the tape.
3. Press Play.

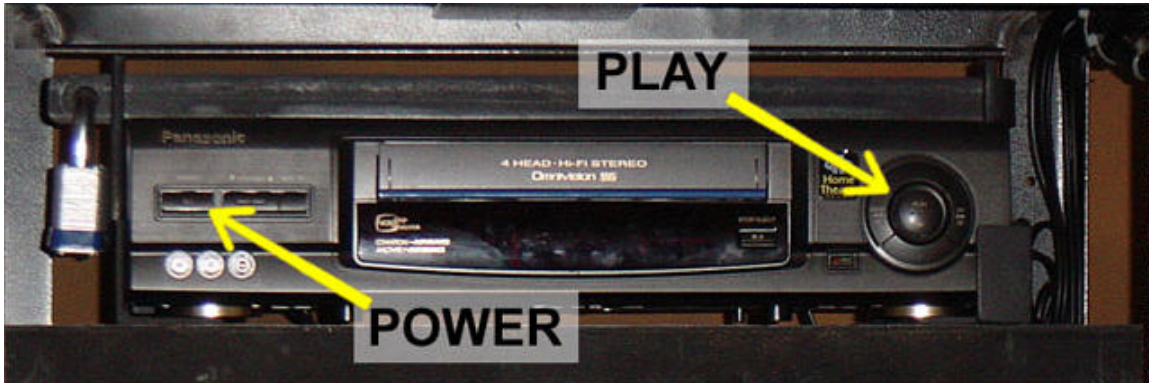


Figure 5: VCR

The DVD Player

1. Press the **Power** Button.
2. Press the **Open/Close** button to access the tray.
3. Load DVD **Label** side up into the tray.
4. Press Play.

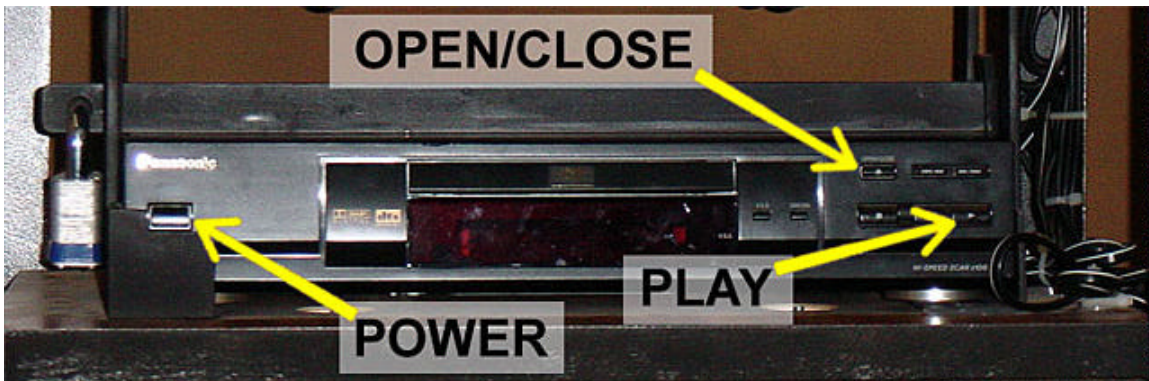


Figure 6: DVD Player

Shutdown

1. Eject the tape from **VCR** by pressing the Stop/Eject button.
2. Remove a **DVD** from the **DVD Player** by pressing the Open/Close button. Press it again to retract the tray after removing the **DVD**.
3. You can turn off the equipment in any order.
4. After turning off the **Video Projector DO NOT UNPLUG THE POWER CART** until the cooling cycle is complete. You will hear a fan turning. When it stops you can unplug the **Power Cart**.
