16 **GRADUATE DEAN'S LIST**

17 The Graduate Dean's List provides for university recognition of its most outstanding graduate students. Candidates
18 for this honor will normally have completed all the coursework applicable to their graduate student programs at this
19 university. The annual list is limited to one percent of the university's graduate enrollment. Those honored will be named
20 in the Commencement Program and will receive a certificate from the administrator in charge of graduate programs or
21 designee.

23 **DEPARTMENTAL GRADUATE STUDENT HONORS**

24 In recognition of outstanding graduate student achievements, departments may honor graduating master's and
25 doctoral degree candidates by special recognition in the annual commencement ceremonies. The number of honors
26 awarded by a department shall be limited to three students or five percent of graduates, whichever is larger.
27 Departmental honors are noted on the student's transcripts. Departmental honors are usually restricted to students not
28 otherwise recognized by university or college awards. These honors are normally conferred for excellence in and
29 contributions to the discipline, including outstanding seminar papers, artistic exhibitions, special achievements in field
30 work, and in university committees and functions, as well as participation in scholarly and professional organizations
31 resulting from student research.
