This program is a partnership of the CSULB Center for Community Engagement and the WomenShelter of Long Beach. Interns will work in the Long Beach Superior Courthouse and interact with attorneys in the specialized domestic violence unit of the Long Beach City Prosecutors Office. Interns will complete 40 hours of state mandated domestic violence training and provide crisis intervention, community resources, and follow up support to victims of domestic violence whose perpetrators are in the court system. A one year commitment is required for 6-8 hours per week. Interns must have reliable transportation, good academic record, feminist consciousness, and a sensitivity and understanding towards domestic violence issues. Possibility of being awarded an AmeriCorps education voucher of \$1000 for a 300 hour commitment over one year for CSULB students.
