2. Run CSLink report LBSR0689 – Class Meeting Times Compliance Report, by subject or college, selecting "lec" and "sem" course components, to determine which classes do not comply.
3. Reschedule non-compliant classes at standard start times or file a request for exception as soon as possible or **by September 15, 2008 at the latest**. Requests submitted after the deadline may not be processed in time for any approved classes to print in the Schedule of Classes or be available for registration.
