The Court has rejected Mr. Arias' request on the grounds that the question of the legitimacy of the dismissal of Senator Susan Casteneda from the A.S. Senate, and a possible violation of her rights has already been answered in a recent Declaratory Judgment filed by R.E. Arias and decided February 10th., 1972. The Court would recommend that Mr. Arias refer to this other case and if he finds his question unanswered to file another Declaratory Judgment stating explicitly what section he finds confusing.

It is so ordered.
