History of the case

Phi Epsilon Kappa, failed to comply with the regulations of the Organizations Commission relating to the filing of the following reports:

- 1) Student Organization Report
- 2) Initiation Practices Certificate
- 3) Roster of Members


The Organizations Commission, in compliance with Chapter III, Section 1, subsection F, paragraph 1a of the Bylaws of the Associated Students of California State College at Long Beach, asked the Associated Students Judiciary to revoke the Charter of Phi Epsilon Kappa.

Decision

Upon the request of the Commissioner of Organizations the Court postponed final judgment until February 9, 1965 in order to give Phi Epsilon Kappa time to comply with the regulations of the Organizations Commission.

Since this Court has received no further word from the Commissioner of Organizations to the contrary, it can only assume that the regulations of the Organizations Commission have been complied with.

IT IS THEREFORE THE DECISION OF THIS COURT THAT Phi Epsilon Kappa is an organization in good standing.
