COMPLAINT TO REQUEST FOR REVIEW

To: Associated Students Judiciary

Date: April 11, 1967

The undersigned does hereby charge that Shelby Wilson and Karla Roberts  
did on the 7th day April 1967, violate the elections code  
of the Associated Students

Description of Charge: Miss Wilson and Miss Roberts did on the above named day  
violate the Associated Students Election Code: Chapter II, Section 2, (sub)section 4.  
Miss Wilson and Miss Roberts did knowingly display campaign material on lower campus in  
front of the Soroptimist house in the parking lot, after 4 p.m. Friday April, 7.

Recommendation for Judgment; The undersigned recommends to the Associated Judiciary  
the following judgment: that Miss Roberts and Miss Wilson be disqualified from  
assuming their senator at large seats in the school year 1967-68, and that the next  
two candidates in line per the election results be seated in place of Roberts and  
Wilson, according to Chapter VIII, Section 2, (sub)Section A. and B. of the Associated  
Students Election Code.

The undersigned does hereby request the Associated Students Judiciary to consider the  
above named charge and render judgment in his favor.

SUMMARY REPORT


Case of: Goldsmith vs Roberts & Wilson

Date: April 12, 1967

Charges: That defendants displayed campaign material after the deadline for removal of such material. Plaintiff seeks the disqualification of the defendants for the above charge.

Decision: The A. S. Judiciary hereby remands this case to the Elections Commission for performance of the following actions pursuant to the required procedure for disqualification (Elections Code of 1966, Chapter VIII, Section 3):

1. Determine if a violation has been committed.
2. Establish the extent of the candidate's knowledge and/or involvement in the violation.
3. Rule on whether the candidates are disqualified, and ~~if so~~ ~~ruled~~, file with the A. S. Judiciary a report containing the basis, evidence, and nature of the decision.
