SUMMARY REPORT

Case of: Heatherington and Gibbons vs Elections Commission

Date : December 7, 1967

Charges: That the Elections Commission did on the 30th day of November, 1967 violate Chapter V, Section 3, Clause B of the Election Code.

Decision: The Court holds that Chapter V, Section 3, B of the A. S. Elections Code is so loose and vaguely constructed as to render it void.

The Court holds the Elections Commission to Chapter V, Section 1; therefore, only the candidates names and the office ~~name~~ which they are seeking shall be designated on the ballot.

The Court recommends that the substantive right granted in Chapter V, Section 3, be clarified and properly placed under Chapter V, Section 1.
