DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

On the petition of the clarification of the Bylaws submitted by William Holmes, Chairman, Experimental College Board, Chapter II, Article III, Section 2-D and Section 3L-1-b. It is the judgment of the court that the Experimental College is a commission, with commission standing and responsibility. The Chairman of the Experimental College must submit the standard rules of procedure for approval according to Chapter II, Article III, Section 2-D. The Experimental College, however, may formulate, administer, and enforce its own code of policy, according to Chapter II, Article III, Section 3L-1-b. It is the judgment of the court that the present code of policy is a combination of both policy and standard rules of procedure and should be separated with the rules of procedure submitted to the Senate for approval. The two sets of documents are not the same, nor do they negate each other; codes of policy are action, decision-making, intent statements, while rules of procedure determine the number of members on the College, establish officer positions and duties, etc.
