Presidential Veto Power

CONFLICT SUMMATION

Petitioner requested judicial review pursuant to the extent of Presidential veto power over financial matters transacted by the Associated Students Senate.

A.S. Bylaws, Chapter I, Article II, Section 4-c provide that:

"Duties and powers of the President. The President shall:  
-Have the power of general or item veto of any measure adopted by the Senate."

A.S. Bylaws, Chapter II, Article II, Section 3-b-1 further provide that:

"The A.S. President shall have the power of general or item veto over measures adopted by the A.S. Senate."

JUDGMENT

It is the decision of the Associated Students Judiciary that the provisions of A.S. Bylaws, Chapter I, Article II, Section 4-c and Chapter II, Article II, Section 3-b-1 setting forth the veto powers of the A.S. President are inclusive, unequivocal and clearly encompass any and all financial matters transacted by the Associated Students Senate.
