



- Don't be afraid to ask for help



- Bachelors, Masters, Med school, law, etc.




In-state tuition: \$7,303*



VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATES

1year of Social Science + 1 year of U.S. History or 1 semester of U.S. History and 1 semester of American Gov.

English - 4 years

Math – 4 years recommended

Minimum 3 years including Algebra II or higher mathematics

Laboratory Science – 3 years recommended Minimum 2 years, must include biological and physical science



Language other than English – 3 years recommended Minimum 2 years, at least 2 years in the same language



Visual and Performing Arts – 1 year Dance, Drama, Theater, Music, or Visual Art






