

# Associated Student, Inc.

## Policy on Accessibility

It is the goal of the Associated Student, Inc. that no program or activity funded by ASI exclude from participation, deny benefits to, or subject to discrimination any individual solely because of his or her disability. To this end, ASI requires that organizations receiving grants take affirmative steps to provide reasonable accommodations in all facilities and services to the known physical or mental limitations of any individuals wishing to participate.

For ASI funded events that have an anticipated attendance of 200 or more students, student organizers **must arrange with their SLD advisor to have a qualified interpreter or transliterator** provide access for hearing impaired attendees. The grant award may cover costs for this service.

This requirement shall apply to programs such as lectures, seminars, workshops, and guest speakers. It shall not apply to concerts or other musical events unless there are significant speaking parts included as part of the event.
