Andrews takes the Presidential Seat After Run-Off Election

Long Beach, CA – After a run-off election and weeks of campaigning, Mark Andrews has taken the seat as California State University, Long Beach 2007-2008 President and CEO of Associated Students, Inc. Voting for the presidential run-off election began March 27-28. Andrews received 50.9% (522 votes) of the 1,027 student votes.

A run-off election was decided because none of the candidates took 51% of the student vote during the general election. Last week Andrews received 35.7%, while Shefali captured 46.7%.

Andrews is taking on the presidential position as a former AS Presidential Cabinet Member. He is currently working for his bachelor's degree in political science.
