EPT Exemption Categories

- SAT I Reasoning Test** - Verbal Section score of 550 or above taken between April 1995 and January 2005.
- SAT Reasoning Test** - Critical Reading Section score of 550 or above taken March 2005 or after.
- SAT Subject Test** - Writing Test score of 680 or above taken between May 1998 and January 2005.
- ACT** - English Test score of 24 or above taken October 1989 or after.
- AP** - Language & Composition or Literature & Composition score of 3 or above.
- EAP** - CA Standards Test in English – “exempt” placement
- College course** - Acceptable transfer course in English Composition grade C or Better.
- Designated subject credential** - Enrolled only for purpose of obtaining a credential
- CSULB job related course** - Staff member enrolled for enrichment; not seeking a degree.

ELM Exemption Categories

- SAT Reasoning Test** - Math section score of 550 or above
- SAT Subject Test** - Math/Math Achievement Test, Level I, IC, II, or IIC 550 or above.
- ACT** - Math Test score of 23 or above.
- AP** - Calculus AB or BC score of 3 or above.
- EAP** - CA Standards Test in HS math or Algebra II – “unconditionally exempt” placement, or “conditionally exempt” placement PLUS successful completion of CSU - approved math course.
- College course** - Acceptable transfer course in quantitative reasoning grade C or better
- Designated subject credential** - Enrolled only for purpose of obtaining a credential.
- CSULB job related course** - Staff member enrolled for enrichment; not seeking a degree.
