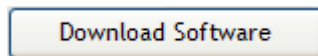


Using ELMS Secure Download - Macintosh

Downloading Software from ELMS is a two part process. The first step is to securely download the installation media. The second step is to install the software. Step one is essentially the same regardless of the software you are downloading and installing. This documentation will guide you through that first step.

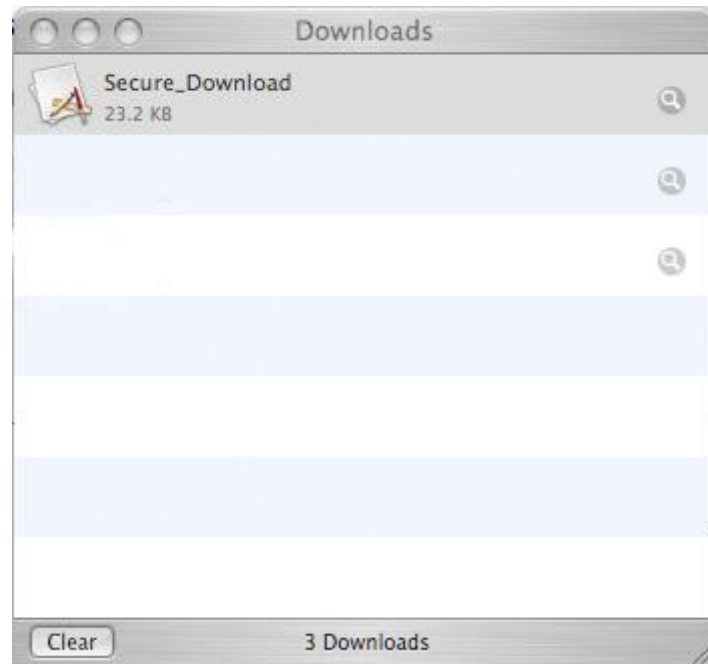
1) When you get to the end of the checkout process for a particular piece of software, you should see a button labeled "Download Software."



2) The next step is to save the secure download client. Note that the name of the client may change depending on the particular piece of software you are downloading. In the example below, the secure download client is named "Secure_Downlaod.app". Click on the "Download" button.



3) When the download is complete, you should see a window that looks like the one below. You should also see an icon for the downloaded client on your desktop. Double click on the icon for the client that is on your desktop to run it.



4) When the "Authorization and Delivery Client" window appears, click on the **Start Download** button.



5) Navigate to your desktop. The icon for the installation archive or file should be there. In our example, the file is a file called "macsav10.zip".



Double click on the icon for the installation archive to open it up. At this point, you can continue the installation process using the specific instructions for the software you are installing.

Once your sure that the software has been downloaded and installed correctly, you can delete the secure download client. If the download of your software is interrupted for some reason, go back to step three and the Secure Download Client should resume the download where it left off when the interruption occurred.
