BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this policy is to safeguard the health and safety of individuals, ensure that facilities are utilized within their designed purposes, facilitate and control utilities consumption, and control facilities maintenance.

Education Code 89031 authorizes the establishment of rules and regulations for the government and maintenance of the buildings and grounds of the California State University. The Trustees and Chancellor of the California State University have delegated this authority to the campus Presidents.

POLICY:

Lodging in Campus Facilities and on Campus Grounds

No person shall at any time lodge or camp on any property owned, operated, or controlled by the University or use any University facility or grounds as a living space except in the Residence Halls or other residential facilities per their established guidelines. Under extraordinary circumstances (natural disaster or the like), the campus President or his designee may grant a temporary exception to this policy.

Violation of this prohibition is a misdemeanor pursuant to Education Code Section 89031 and Penal Code Section 647(j).

Lodging in Vehicles

No person shall use any motor vehicle located on campus grounds for the purpose of habitation or camping without the express written permission of the University President or designee. "Habitation" includes one or more of the following activities: sleeping between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.; cooking and/or food preparation; and washing/showering.

Violation of this prohibition is a misdemeanor pursuant to Education Code Section 89031 and Penal Code Section 647(j).
