INSIGHTS 2008: THE ANNUAL STUDENT EXHIBITION **May 15 – June 1, 2008**

The University Art Museum and the Department of Art present the annual student exhibition, *INSIGHTS 2008*. The exhibit will be on view beginning May 15 through June 1, 2008 and will feature work by both graduate and undergraduate students from the Department of Art, California State University, Long Beach. Juried by the Department of Art faculty members and distinguished alumni, the exhibition highlights work by students in all disciplines including ceramics, drawing and painting, fiber, graphic design, illustration/animation, metal, photography, printmaking, and wood.

The Department of Art will present the Student Award Ceremony on May 15 at 5 PM in the Horn Center to honor students who have excelled in their media. This ceremony is open to students, parents, the faculty and staff at CSULB, and the general public. The reception for the artists will be held in the museum immediately following the ceremony.
