- III. **Summer committee updates:** The summer workgroup discussed the future without the GPE as an assessment tool and proposed ideas to strengthen existing pillars of writing at the university.
 - a. CEPC wants everything that the summer group came up with
 - b. Brown states that it is too much to ask the summer workgroup to take all our ideas and put them into policy writing, and the collection of ideas is good enough to give to CEPC.
- IV. The next couple of GWARC meetings will be dedicated to editing and adding to what was already created from the summer workgroup.
 - a. Brown: Other colleges are putting together some ambitious writing intensive proposals - Chico state is proposing a 4-course requirement on their campus. This includes an undergrad course (comp 100) and 3 division upper division courses focusing on writing, one class has to be discipline specific, and the other two can be flexible.
- V. Brown: Chancellor's office states that the undergraduate summer bridge program is being abolished without something to replace it.
