  - 4.1. Followup regarding best media for receiving news from ATS
    - 4.1.1. (Shariq) Typically sent via LMS announcements or direct emails to faculty; there are concerns about the best way to communicate time-sensitive information
      - 4.1.1.1. Semester updates, along with topic-specific announcements, emailed to All Faculty. Some are not being read. Direct feedback from faculty is welcome now or later.
        - 4.1.1.1. (Chung-min) Suggestion to directly email Chair to email the Dept./Program Chair emails are often more noticed by faculty
          - 4.1.1.1.1.1. (Shariq) Will forward important emails specifically to Chairs
          - 4.1.1.1.2. (Chung-min) regarding awareness of/emails about iSpace, faculty may just not see/understand/imagine how they may use it.
        - 4.1.1.1.2. (Nancy) Faculty Affairs also lists Weekly What's Happening items that include ATS/Canvas Workshops
          - 4.1.1.2.1. (Jim) Is there particular outreach for making sure adjuncts received announcements?
            - 4.1.1.1.2.1.1. (Shariq) All Faculty email listserv should include them but cannot control when that email list is updated.
  - 4.2. Followup regarding ChatGPT
    - 4.2.1.1. (Nancy) Will CSULB have some kind of plagiarism statement regarding GPT? Or should it be department-based?
      - 4.2.1.1.1. (Shariq) not quite ready to make a statement; ATS would like to organize a discussion session with faculty about ChatGPT and AI; potentially near the end of this SP23 semester. Nancy (for Faculty

Affairs) and Tracey Mayfield (for the Library) would be asked to be involved.
