This will free up WTU for faculty to teach the class and cost effective for graduate advising.</li> <li>This AY2-23, COE supports 7 full-time faculty, including Chair of Electrical Engineering, which includes new computer engineering and computer science (CECS) full time faculty.</li> <li>Suzanne from CLA – geography department would like to collaborate with this new program. In addition, there is a concern once students are sent to various majors for exploration, how the advising will be handled because students will conduct work outside CECS.</li> <li>Nancy responds that centralized advising will be employed for Data Science program. There will be only 2 exploration elective courses outside CECS.</li> <li>Jesse concurs that centralized advising is a strategy to safeguard student success.</li> <li>Math and Statistics department raises a concern of curriculum overlapping.
