Resolution in Support of Shared Governance in Enrollment Management Decision Making

- Whereas:** CSULB is committed to the principle of Shared Governance, where appropriate stakeholders are consulted prior to any decision making;
- Whereas:** The CSULB Academic Senate, according to its mission, “acts as a consultative body to other constituencies on all matters it or the President deems pertinent to the welfare of the University”;
- Whereas:** CSULB senior administration decided to restructure Enrollment Services without consultation with the appropriate shared governance body; and
- Whereas:** CSULB senior administration decided to change the admission standards for select applicants without consultation with the appropriate shared governance body in Fall 2023.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- Resolved:** The CSULB Academic Senate encourages the administration to respect and follow the highly valued principle of shared governance.
- Resolved:** The CSULB administration is urged to consult with the Advisory Council on Strategic Enrollment Management (ACSEM) regarding decisions and proposed changes affecting enrollment.
