## **GS 700 Policy**

## Approved by the CED Graduate Programs Committee, October 3, 2018

The College of Education supports graduate student academic progress and timely degree completion. In accordance with Academic Senate Policy Statement 18-03: Graduate Studies 700, the College of Education provides students with the opportunity to enroll in a maximum of two semesters of GS 700 with program/department approval. Students who have completed two semesters (including summer or winter sessions) of GS 700, but do not complete the exit requirement within this time period, will be prevented from further enrollment and therefore may not complete their degrees.

Under extenuating circumstances, students may, with program advisor/thesis chair approval, submit an exception request form to the Associate Dean for Graduate Studies to continue subsequent enrollment in GS 700. Requests to enroll in more than two GS 700 courses are only approved in rare cases where progress toward the degree is hindered by exceptional circumstances beyond the student's control.
