

## Worksheet for History Majors in the Subject Matter Program

This worksheet is intended to help CSULB history majors who are interested in becoming secondary teachers plan their coursework to complete the major and the subject matter program at the same time. Please note that the History Major worksheet—and the authority of the History advisors—overrides any information on this page.

### I. Lower Division—9 units

The History major requires nine units of lower-division surveys. The subject matter program, however, requires <b>each</b> of the following lower-division surveys

### II. Upper Division

#### A. Core courses—15 units

1. Core classes do not count toward the subject matter program
2. Ethnicity, Gender, Race → 3 units. Please consult the History Major Worksheet for eligible classes. This course counts toward your “Upper Division Diversity in History” requirement in the subject matter program.

#### B. Areas of Concentration—18 units

1. Option 1: nine units x two areas of concentration
