- 1. Name: List full name
- Social Security Number: Enter US social security number issued by the US Social Security Administration. Do not list numbers not assigned by US Social Security, i.e. Canadian social security numbers. If none, enter your TIN issued by IRS. If SSN not yet available, attach proof of application thereof.
- 3. List telephone number.
- 4. Pesonal Email.
- 5. CSULB Email Address and 9 digit campus ID, if applicable.
- 6. Local Street Address in U.S.
- 7. Residence: List your non-US address

P-3 Culturally Unique Performers/Group

- 8. Country of Citizenship.
- Country that issued the passport: List Country in which you were issued your passport.
- 10. Passport #. Enter your passport number.
- 11. Enter your Foreign Taxpayer ID Number.
- 12. If you had previous immigration status in the U.S., select "Yes".
- 13. If you applied/granted Legal Permanent Residency, select "Yes"
