- V. Discussion: GE Policy Updates (Tentative)a. Another issue came up at Academic Senate and postponed the vote.

 - a. New Courses
 - i. EE 350 Energy Conversion Principles (asking for UD D3 Social Sciences & Citizenship)
 - 1. The committee does not see how this course corresponds with Area D3.
 - 2. Justification: This section is not clear in terms of relating the course content and its relationship with Area D3 description and GELOs.
 - 3. SLOs: Members do not see the interdisciplinary relationship between engineering and social sciences.
 - a. Theories from a social science perspective is missing from the SLOs.
 - 4. Assessments: Members saw no evidence of integrating discipline and Area D3.
 - 5. Outline: The topics are electrical engineering, with no apparent connection to social sciences.
 - 6. Bibliography: It is not clear which texts correspond to Area D3.
