Parking and Transportation Advisory Committee members are asked to commit to meeting for one hour once each month, to allocate time to speak with other constituents in their area(s), research and recommend innovative solutions and provide feedback to the committee in an effort to improve the parking and transportation experience for the campus community and to help Parking and Transportation Services meet the following goals:

- Provide equitable access to parking for students, faculty and staff.
- Provide meaningful transportation programs and services for our students, faculty and staff that support sustainable commute choices and reduces CSULB's carbon footprint.
- Address general parking issues and concerns.
