Description of the Signature Assignment

Candidates prepare a culminating research study describing their work to include: the issue under investigation, a review of related literature, data collection methods, findings and analysis/discussion, and recommendations for problem resolution.

Directions for Students

- Develop an outline for a study of a school/district-based problem, policy, or issue utilizing an appropriate research design, literature review, and data collection strategies;
- Conduct a review of the literature;
- Conduct the study to include collecting appropriate data related to the problem under investigation
- Analyze, synthesize and interpret data and discuss the findings;
- Present conclusions and recommendations for problem solution;
- Present the study, in written form according to guidelines provided in class.
