Master's degree (or equivalent) in the in appropriate discipline(s). Demonstrated potential for effective teaching in lecture and/or discussion sections of Experience Success Program 1; Experience Success Program 2; Project Management for Scientists; Leadership and Management for Scientists; Accounting and Finance for Scientists; Introduction to Regulatory Science; or Professional Ethics. Alternatively, demonstrated potential for effective supervision of students placed in internships and effective networking to establish internship positions for students enrolled in Internships in Natural Sciences. Commitment to and/or expertise in educating a diverse student population.

Desired/Preferred Qualifications

Demonstrated success in teaching of undergraduates and/or graduate students. Alternatively, demonstrated success in supervising students in internships and establishing internship positions for students.

Duties

On a part-time basis, teaching Natural Science (NSCI) courses or supervising students in internships and establishing internship positions for students. Courses to be taught may be offered as lecture and/or activity sections or as hybrid course sections.
