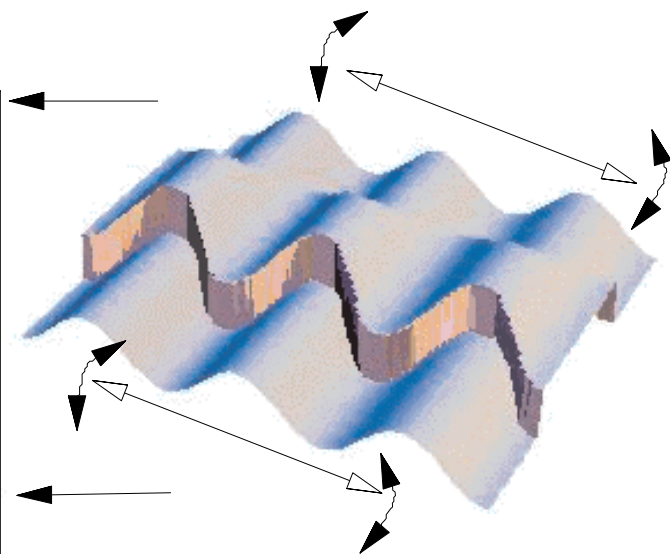
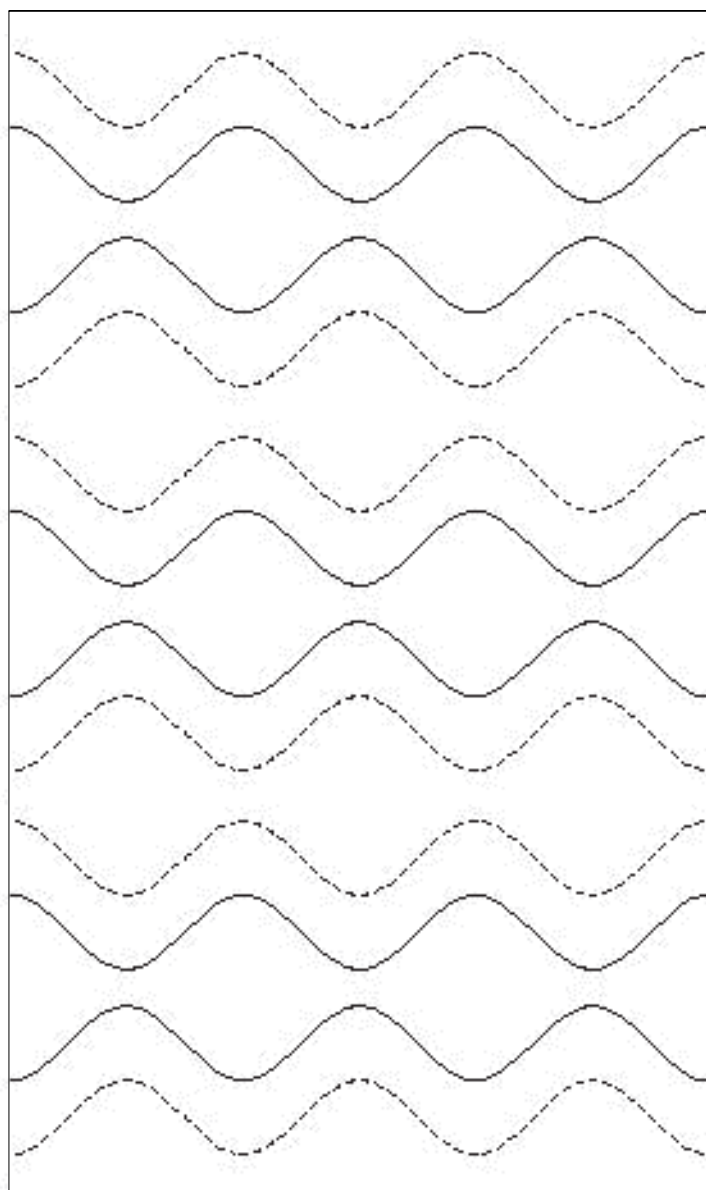


SINE-WOBBLER

Transfer the pattern below to your working paper, and score the mountain creases on the top side of the paper, and the valley creases on the bottom side of the paper. Working from the top to the bottom, fold along the scored creases. A single repeat domain in its final folded form is shown.



To play with the wobbler, compress it along its longest dimension, and then twist the upper and lower edges against each other gently. If made of sturdy blue cardstock, your blue wobbler can induce sea sickness.

Fold a traditional masu before you start playing ... just in case.
