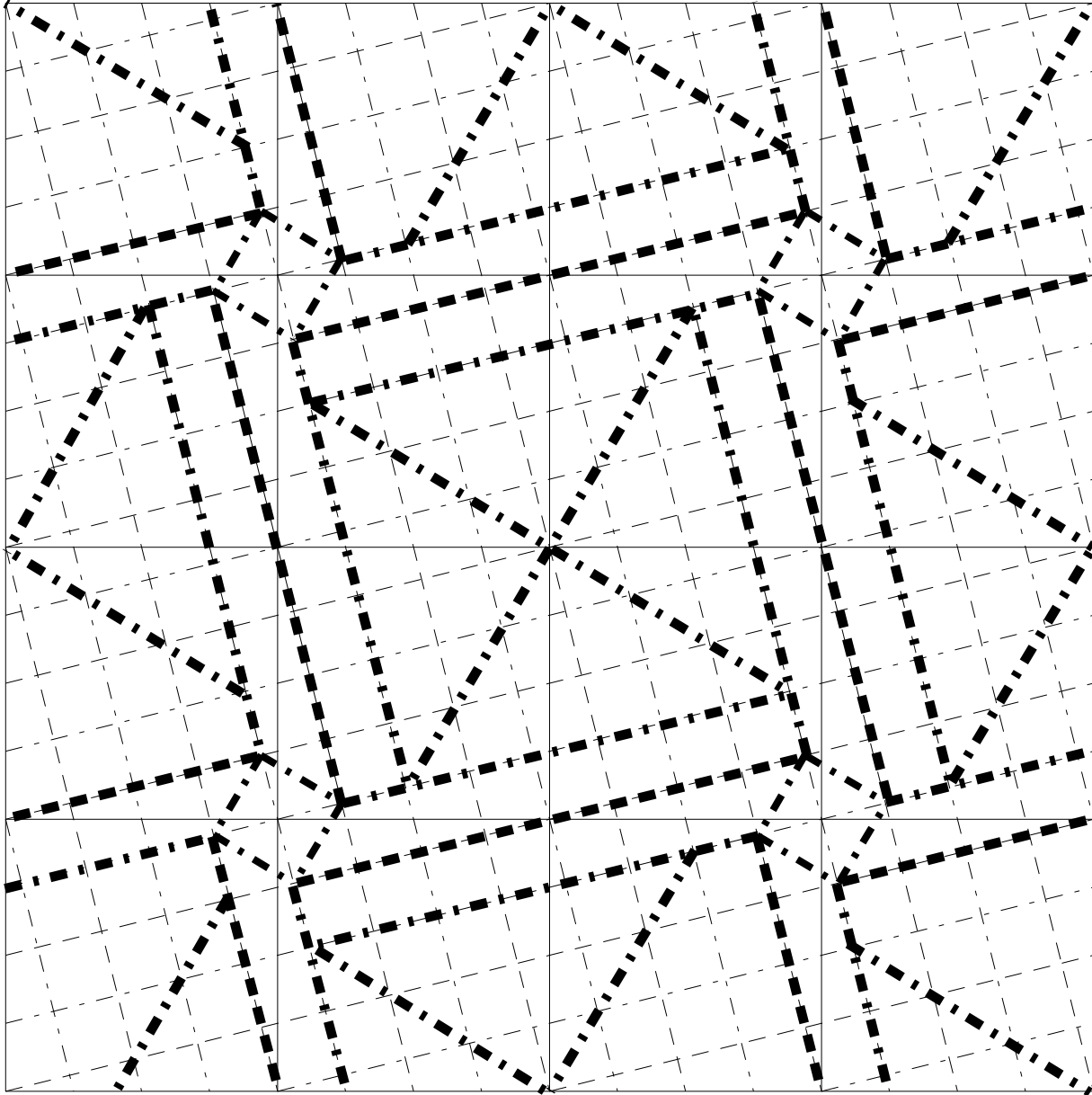

Field of 4 roses: Precreasing, white side up:  
The 4:1 slope of the twist axes is arbitrary ... any angle will do.



Forming the 4 sinks will produce twisting pleats on the reverse side that will not lay flat. Go on to form a Kawasaki twist-rose in each of the 4 sectors, and you will have the symmetric twisting field of roses, very much like the reverse-engineered V. Vann anti-symmetric twisting pattern.
