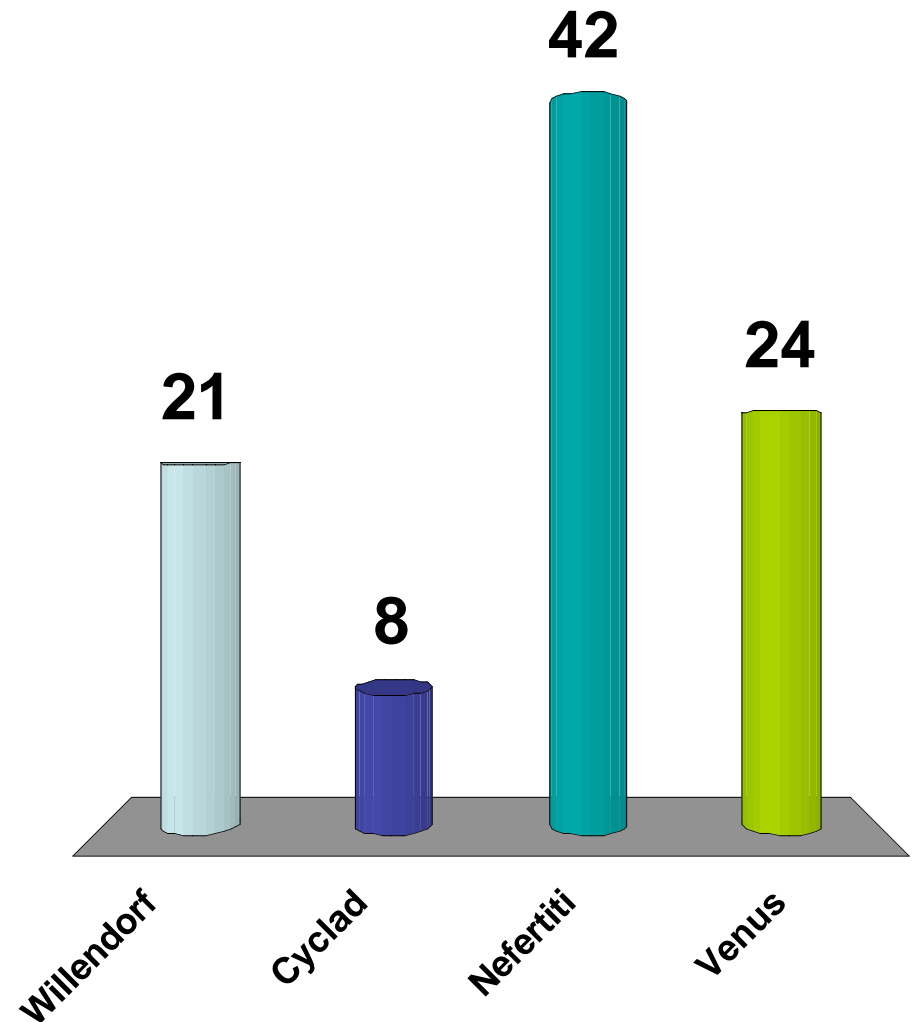

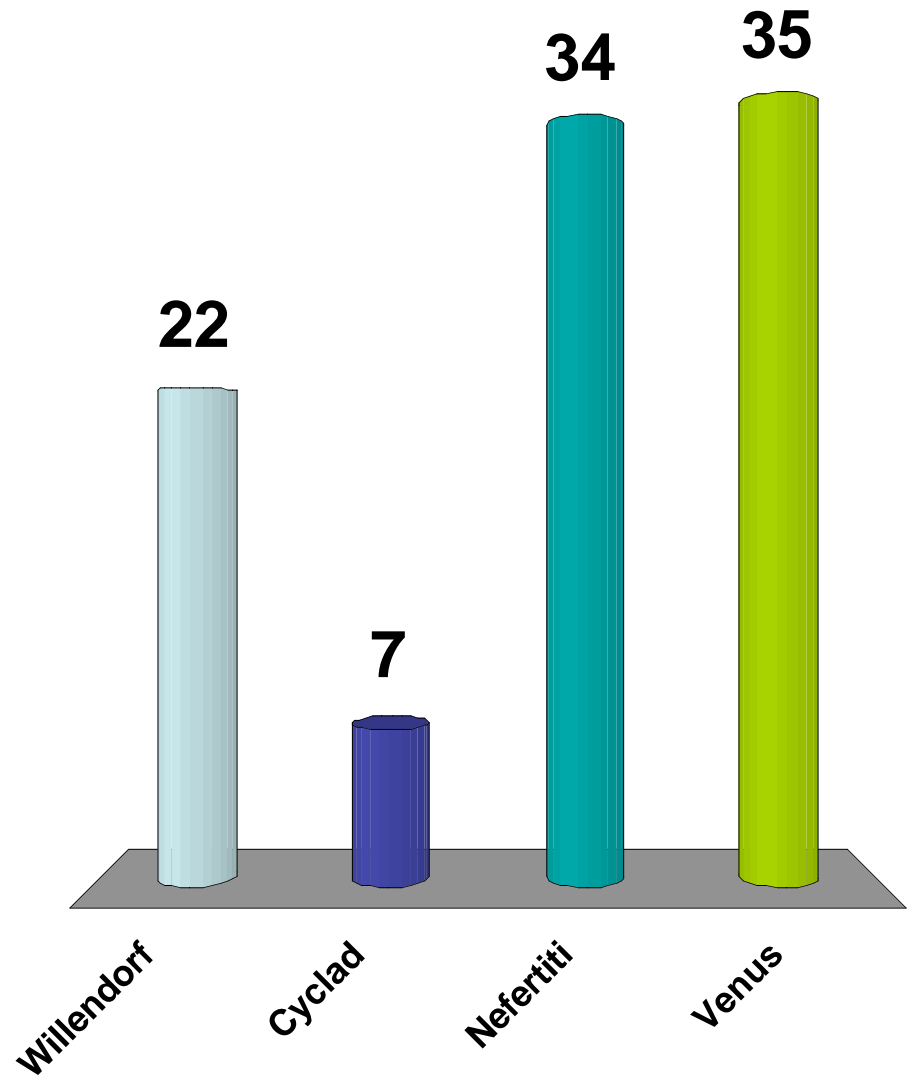

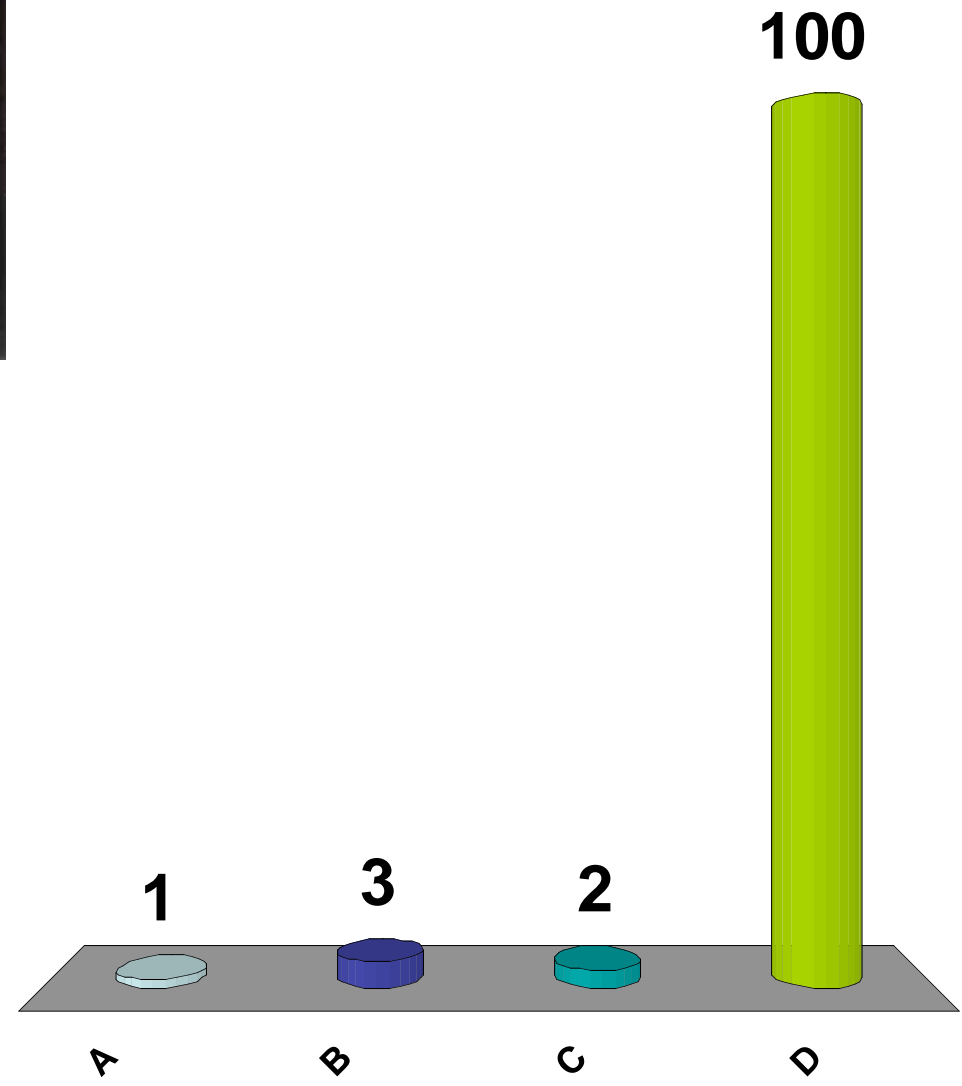

- 1400 BCE • Oracle at Delphi - early “telepsychic”
- 1180 • Hildegard of Bingen - *Scivias*
- 1429 • Joan of Arc - saved a kingdom, crowned a king
- 1557 • St. Teresa - stabbed in heart by angel
- 1850 • Fyodor Dostoyevsky - epilepsy
- 1888 • Vincent van Gogh- temporal lobe epilepsy
- 1912 • Claude Monet - cataracts
- 1938 • Jackson Pollock - alcoholism
- 1978 • Paddy Chayefsky - *Altered States*
- 1980 • Ken Russell - *Altered States*
- 1987 • Jean-Michel Basquiat - heroin, etc.
- 1988 • Chuck Close - spinal artery “incident”
